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Outline	In this course, students will learn the latest research results and methods in the field of clinical medicine or social medicine by participating in NIPS Research Meetings.
Learning objectives	The goal of this course is to deepen students' knowledge not only of physiology as the basic medicine in which they conduct research, but also of medicine in general, including clinical medicine and social medicine.
Grading policy	Students are required to attend at least two NIPS Research Meetings that the faculty determines to be deeply related to clinical medicine or social medicine. Students are required to submit 1) a participation record form (including the name of meeting, date and time of the meeting, and signature of the person in charge at NIPS) and 2) a written report on one of the meetings they attended to Vice-Chair of Department of Physiological Sciences by the end of the month before the end of the semester. Attendance at the two workshops is a requirement, and the grade will be evaluated by Vice-Chair of Department based on the contents of the report. The participation record form should be requested from Vice-Chair after registration.
Lecture Plan	NIPS Research Meetings related to clinical or social medicine are determined in April. Each NIPS Research Meeting may be held on one day or divided into two days.
