The Department of System Neuroscience at the National Institute for Physiological Sciences invites applications for two, non-PI researcher positions at the level of Assistant Professor. We are seeking candidates with expertise in systems neuroscience using awake, behaving monkeys. Preference will be given to individuals (i) who have research experience with social neuroscience studies and have a strong potential for developing interdisciplinary investigations in related fields or (ii) who have expertise in electrophysiology and neuroanatomy and have a strong passion to conduct research programs related to social neuroscience. Applicants are expected to be involved in educational programs for graduate students as a faculty of SOKENDAI (The Graduate School for Advanced Studies).

Qualifications:

Applicants should have a Ph.D. degree in neuroscience or related fields.

Number of positions:

Two Assistant Professors or Project Assistant Professors (depending on achievement).

Term and conditions:

Full-time position with an initial contract of five years. Reappointment may be possible depending on achievement.
